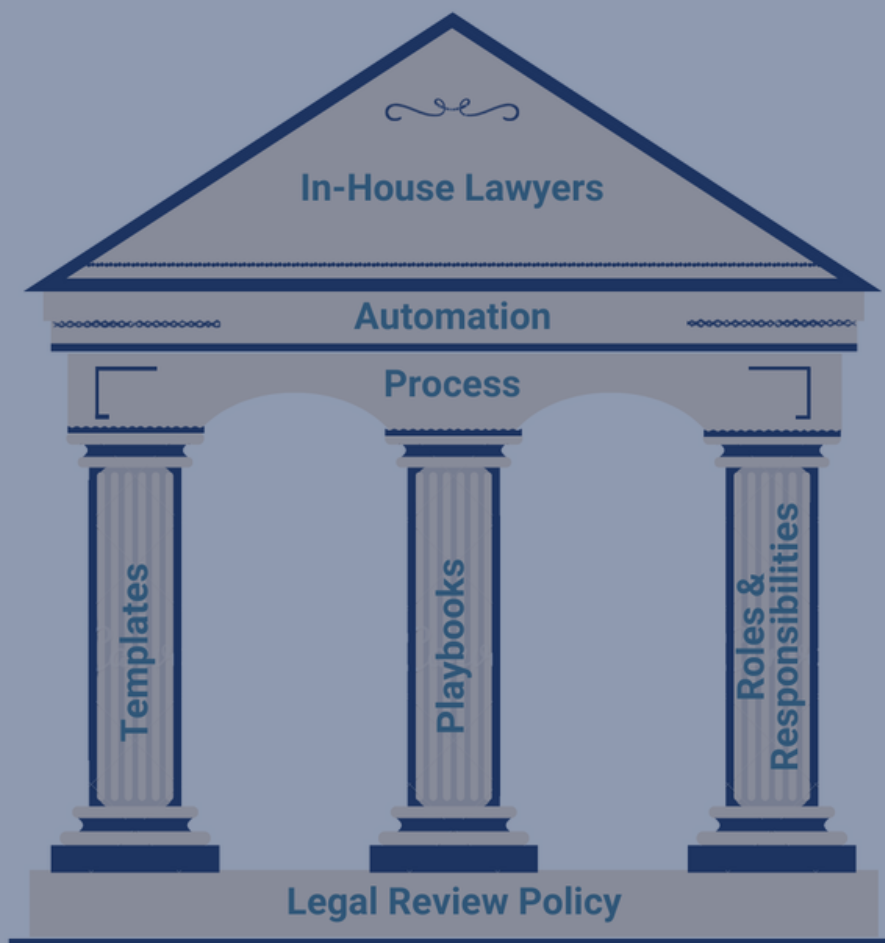


CLM Simplified Workshops

CLM Readiness

InnoLaw works with prospective and current customers of CLM tech providers to:

- Confirm the goals for automation: contract template generation, workflow optimization or storage and data extraction; or all of the above
- Define the specific scope of the contract types and volumes that will be enabled through automation
- Develop a prioritized and detailed list of business requirements for alignment with the system features
- Prepare a governance plan for the overall contracting operation (roles & responsibilities matrices, contract review policy and program stakeholders), which includes ongoing system management
- Map more efficient current state processes
- Consult with CLM tech providers on a flexible draft implementation plan that is phase-based on prospect's culture, milestones, and other defined needs or restrictions

Choose from:

- **Masterclass:** A hands-on half-day program (3-4 hours) with instructor-led work through the components of readiness, after which the attendees will have developed the core documentation needed for launching a new system or optimizing the one they have recently implemented. Each master class is tailored to the customer, through a prep session for InnoLaw to get a general understanding of the current state and goals for the workshop.
- **Crash Course:** 90-minute presentation-style program where attendees are guided through the various components of CLM readiness and enabled with homework to complete independently.
